Time: Mon and Wed 5:30-6:30

Cost before Feb 15: \$160, after Feb 15 \$180

Grand Slam (Previously Rookie): Ages 2009-2010

Time: Tues, Thur, Sat (any 2 of these days) between 5:30-8:00

Cost before Feb 15 \$180, after Feb 15 \$200

Mosquito: Ages 2007-2008

Time: Mon, Wed, Fri, Sat (any two of these days) 6:00-8:00 6 innings

Cost before Feb 15 \$200, after Feb 15 \$220

PeeWee: Ages 2005-2006

Time: Tues, Thur, Sat (any 2 of these days) 6:00-8:00 7 innings

Cost before Feb 15 \$240, after Feb 15 \$260

Bantam: Ages 2003-2004

When families need a little financial boost to get kids involved in a sport, dance team or other active program, they need to fill out an application. This needs to be done before the fees are due, as the money goes right to the organization. Applications for assistance can typically be submitted from January 15 to November 1; with the goal for funding to be equitably distributed over Spring/Summer and Fall/Winter activities.

Jumpstart has you covered. The application asks for equipment details. Funds can also be provided for adaptive equipment to help kids with special needs.
